

Why I'm running

I'm running for Indiana Secretary of State to safeguard democracy and the freedom to vote right here at home. I have worked at all levels of government—local, state, federal, and the multi-national level with NATO. As an attorney, I've served as Associate Corporation Counsel for Marion County, the City of Indianapolis, and as Deputy Attorney General for the State of Indiana. And as a military intelligence officer, I have seen first hand the state of democracy across our globe.

How we'll win

Indiana isn't a Blue State. It isn't a Red State. We're a purple state with a turnout problem. The Supreme Court overturning Roe v. Wade is galvanizing voters across the state and activating concerned citizens every day. We only need to expand our base vote by 8-10% while winning 55% of Independent voters. My experiences growing up in rural Indiana and serving in the military resonates with the experiences of Hoosiers across the state.

2022 is also feeling a lot like 2012, when Glenda Ritz rode the wave of discontent among teachers across the state. We need to be sure we can capitalize on the momentum of those upset with both women's rights and the GOP anti-democratic movement this year and compete.

Finally, my opponent, Diego Morales, is a deeply flawed candidate. He was dismissed from both jobs he was given in the Secretary of State's office. He seeks to make voting more difficult in Indiana by severely restricting absentee voting and early voting, and to require voters to prove they are a citizen when they cast their vote. I'm the only pro-Democracy candidate in this race, and Hoosiers both moderate and progressive are recognizing that.

FAQ/NEXT STEPS

Are there limits to how the campaign can support my event?

Yes. Some limits are due to campaign finance rules, best practices, and our unfortunate inability to clone Destiny. Here are some of the things we can't do:

- Reimburse or cover the cost of your event.
- Provide insurance or liability coverage.
- Guarantee attendance of Destiny if an event is scheduled without our input.

Does the campaign have to approve my event?

Technically, no, but we'd love to know about it, to help you be successful, provide resources, make sure that we are following best practices, and avoid potential issues. We also can't be there if we don't know about it.
